

2017 Call for Board of Directors Nominations Quint Development Corporation

Quint uses a community economic development approach to enhance the economic and social well-being for Saskatoon's west side core neighbourhoods. This is done by providing programs and services in the areas of housing, employment and training and social enterprise development.

Quint Development Corporation's Board of Directors is currently seeking nominations for Director Positions commencing June 2017 for a 2 year term.

Board members responsibilities include:

1. Regularly attend Board meetings. The Board meets around 10 times per year.
2. Be a member of one of the four standing committees – Finance, Community, Governance or Nominations.
3. Understand the roles and responsibilities of a Board member:
4. Utilize personal and professional skills, relationships and knowledge for the advancement of Quint Development Corporation's mission.

The Current Board of Directors is a diverse group with a wide range of skills. We are also inviting individuals who have an interest in community economic development within the core neighbourhoods. In identifying suitable candidates the nominations committee shall consider:

- Candidates from a wide range of backgrounds.
- Candidates on merit and against objective criteria, and with due regard for the benefits of diversity of the Board, including gender and the social composition of the Core Neighbourhoods.
- Take care that appointees have enough time available to devote to the position.
- Understanding and remaining current on west side core neighbourhood issues.

Please note there is a 2 deadline requirement in submitting your Board nomination.

- 1) Board positions are open to members of Quint Development Corporation. Deadline to become a member before submitting your nomination to the board is April 26th, 2017.

This statement will be reviewed by the Board and must be received May 31st, 2017 , 14 days prior to the Annual General Meeting happening June 14th, 2017.
