



## **Quint Youth Lodge Program Staff (Over-nights and Weekday – Permanent Fulltime)**

Quint Development Corporation is a unique community economic development organization, focused on strengthening communities and improving social conditions for Saskatoon residents. The goal is to create opportunities for affordable housing, jobs, and economic development in Saskatoon's west-side core neighbourhoods.

The Quint Youth Lodge is seeking interested candidates to facilitate the day-to-day operations. The Youth Lodge is a transitional residence for up to 10 youth 16 to 21 years old. The objective of the Lodge is to assist resident's transition to successful independent living by providing safe and supportive housing with linkages to education, training and employment.

Program staff assist in all daily activities with emphasis on life skills training, and employment development activities as related to the residents, as well as assisting in the operations of the program.

Qualifications for this position is:

- Availability for overnights (12am-8am) on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday (8am-4pm) day shift.
- Desire to work with and believe in the potential of youth
- Experience working with people from marginalized communities
- Knowledge of the beliefs and values of Aboriginal cultures
- Awareness of community resources and how to access them
- Excellent leadership, organizational and communication skills
- Mediation/conflict resolution and problem solving skills;
- Post-secondary education in the human services field, equivalent experience or a combination of both

Duties may include:

- Support for youth involved with this program
- Consulting with co-workers in the development and follow through of resident's case plans
- Recording of information / filing / journal entries
- Meal preparation / cleaning / general maintenance
- Room checks / supervision

Requirements:

- Must provide a criminal record check
- Valid driver's license is an asset
- Proof of vaccination upon hire
