DUTIES:

- With crew, identify personal and professional goals and develop strategies for achieving them
- Identify limiting patterns and barriers for crew and provide solution focused interventions as needed
- Maintain case files to support ongoing follow-up
- Participate in onboarding and intake processes of crew
- Identify and understand community services, education and training opportunities/resources
- With senior staff, devise and plan training program tailored to crew needs
- Develop job transition processes for participants exiting the program, encompassing employment, educational or social support options
- Develop and maintain networks with local stakeholders to enhance transitional opportunities
- Occasional crew transport on case-by-case basis
