As our Outreach Support Worker, you'll build trusting relationships with participants, help them overcome personal and employment barriers, and connect them with the resources they need to succeed both during and after the program.

Responsibilities

- Support participant hiring, onboarding and intake.
- Help participants identify goals and develop strategies to achieve them.
- Provide coaching, encouragement and accountability while helping participants navigate barriers.
- Connect participants with community resources, education and training opportunities.
- Coordinate certifications, tickets and skill development.
- Maintain accurate case files and participant documentation.
- Develop transition plans for employment, education or other community supports.
- Build strong relationships with community agencies and stakeholders.
- Provide occasional transportation for participants.

- Genuine, approachable and non-judgmental.
- Skilled at building trust while maintaining healthy boundaries.
- Calm under pressure and comfortable having difficult conversations.
- Organized, proactive and able to balance people-focused work with documentation.
- Passionate about helping people succeed.

- Knowledge of poverty, systemic barriers and community resources.
- Familiarity with Harm Reduction principles.
- Related post-secondary education is an asset.
